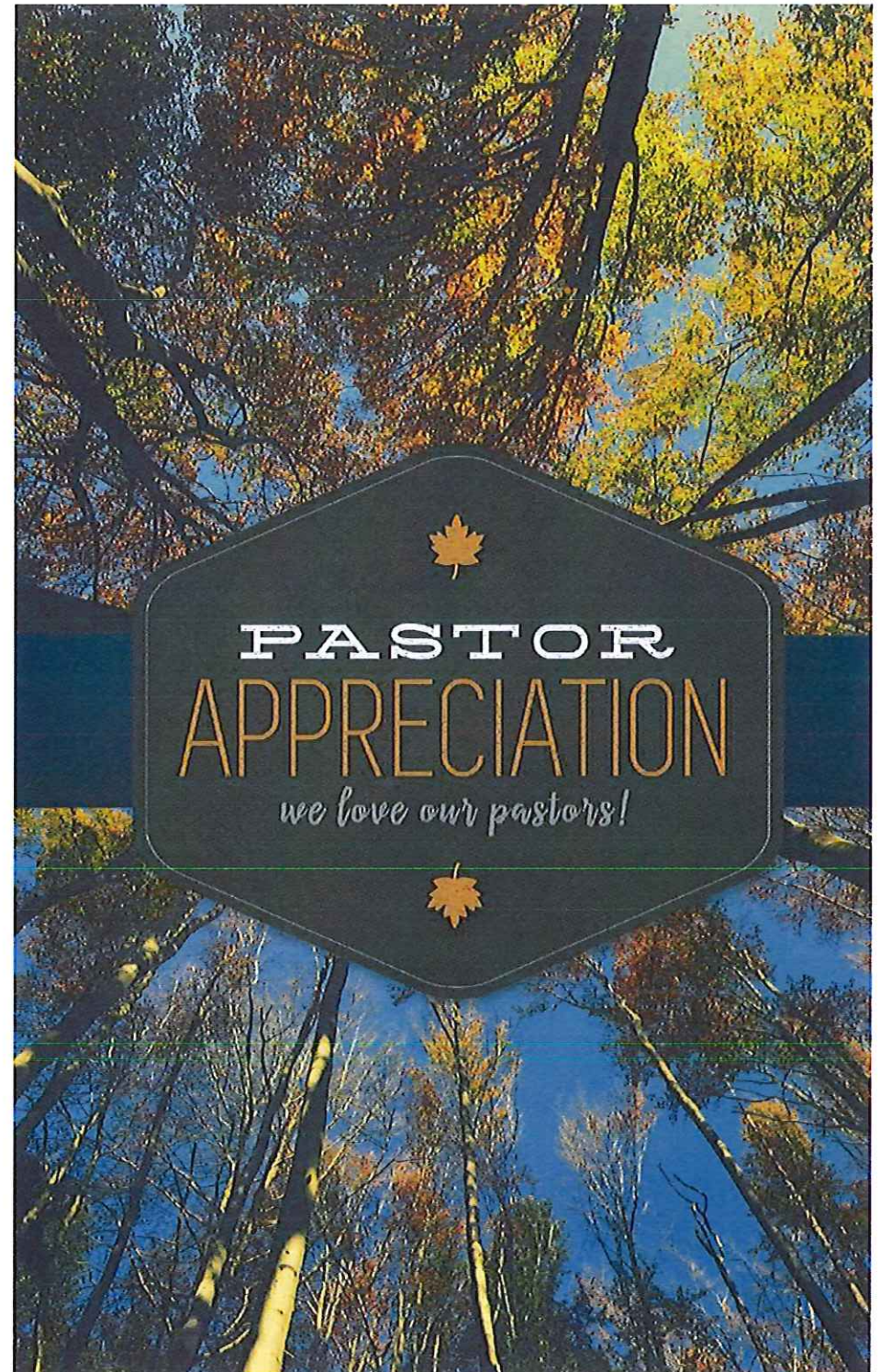

Galatians 5:16-26

“Live by the Power of the Holy Spirit”

I. We are at war. (vv. 16-18)

16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. 17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. - **Galatians 5:16-18 NKJV**

15 For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. ... 19 For the good that I will [to do], I do not do; but the evil I will not [to do], that I practice. - **Romans 7:15, 19 NKJV**

II. Our flesh works in rebellion against God. (vv. 19-21)

19 Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told [you] in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. - **Galatians 5:19-21 NKJV**

Four Groups

Sensual sins: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness

Religious sins: idolatry, sorcery

Interpersonal sins: hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambition, dissensions, heresies, envy, murder

Social sins: drunkenness, revelries

6 For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives." - **Hebrews 12:6 NKJV**

III. The Spirit produces fruit in us. (vv. 22-23)

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. - **Galatians 5:22-23 NKJV**

“Joy is love singing, peace is love resting, patience is love enduring, kindness is love sharing, goodness it love’s character, faithfulness is love’s habit, gentleness is love’s touch, self-control is love in charge.”

IV. To win the war requires our action. (vv. 24-26)

24 And those [who are] Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. - **Galatians 5:22-26 NKJV**

4 "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. - **John 15:4 NKJV**

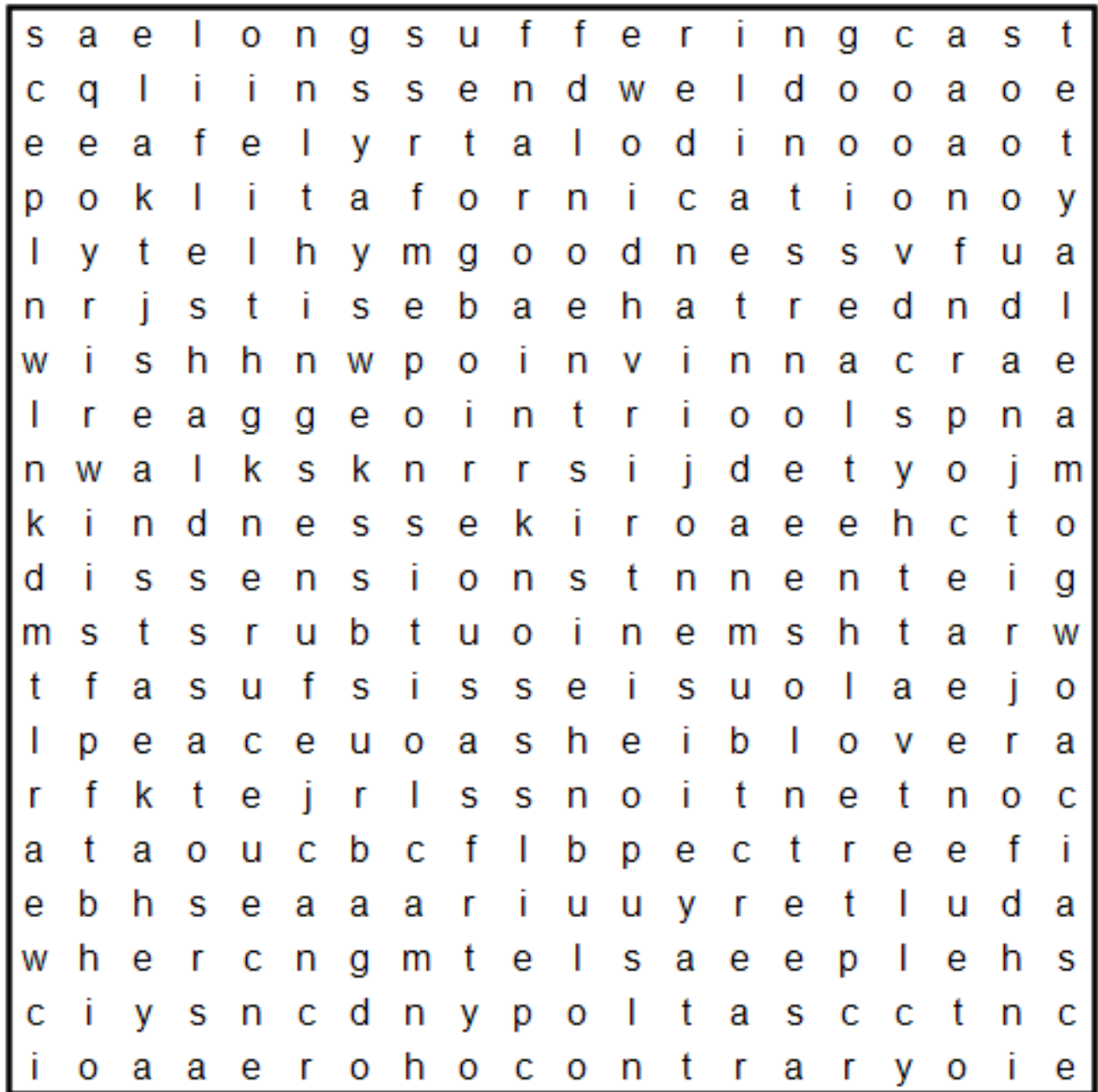
