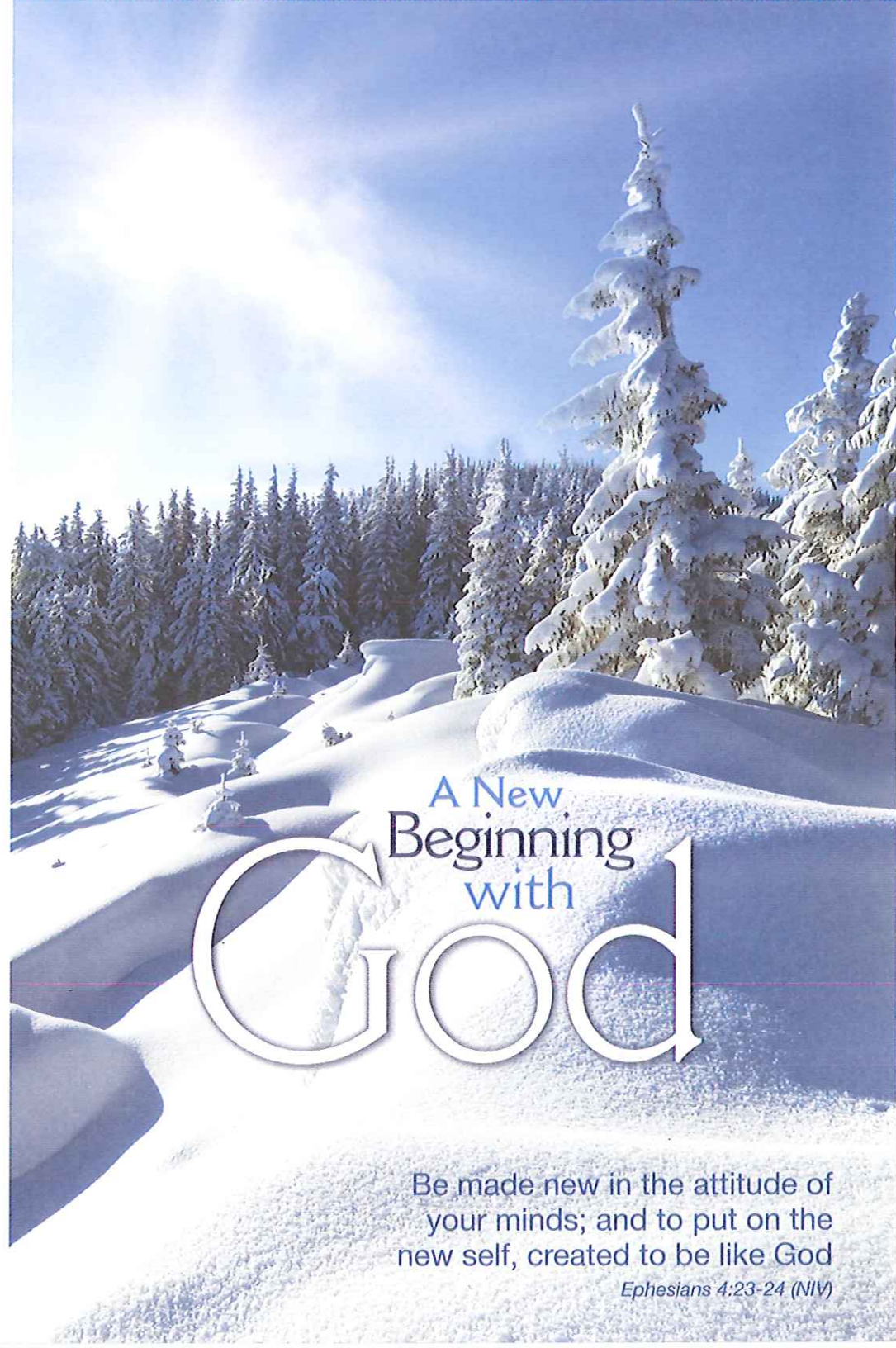

## “How Do We Live as We Wait?”

35 "Stay dressed for action and keep your lamps burning, 36 and be like men who are waiting for their master to come home from the wedding feast, so that they may open the door to him at once when he comes and knocks. 37 Blessed are those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. Truly, I say to you, he will dress himself for service and have them recline at table, and he will come and serve them. - **Luke 12:35-37 ESV**

### I. We Wait.

9 The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. - **2 Peter 3:9 ESV**

20 He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! - **Revelation 22:20 ESV**

8 You also, be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand. - **James 5:8 ESV**

### II. We obey God.

24 When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, - **Matthew 1:24 ESV**

38 And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.  
- **Luke 1:38 ESV**

21 And at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

22 And when the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord

... 39 And when they had performed everything according to the Law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. ...

41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. 42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up according to custom. ... 51 And he went down with them and came to Nazareth and was submissive to them. And his mother treasured up all these things in her heart. - **Luke 2:21-22, 39, 41-42, 51 ESV**

48 But if that wicked servant says to himself, 'My master is delayed,' 49 and begins to beat his fellow servants and eats and drinks with drunkards, 50 the master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he does not know 51 and will cut him in pieces and put him with the hypocrites. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. - **Matthew 24:45-51 ESV**

### III. We live life.

2 And on the Sabbath he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were astonished, saying, "Where did this man get these things? What is the wisdom given to him? How are such mighty works done by his hands? 3 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him. - **Mark 6:2-3 ESV**

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." - **Matthew 28:19-20 ESV**

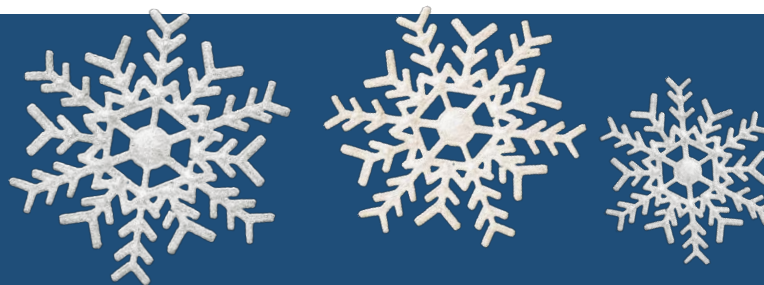
