1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. 2 And after fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. 3 And the tempter came and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command these stones to become loaves of bread." 4 But he answered, "It

is written, "'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." ... 11 Then the devil left him, and behold, angels came and were ministering to him. - Matthew 4:1-4, 11 ESV

Where are you tempted to take matters into your own hands? Wait on God.

III. The only way that we can be spiritually nourished is by feeding on God's word.


Prayer Requests from our neighbors:
