## **“Man Does Not Live by Bread Alone”**

2 And you shall remember the whole way that the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments or not. 3 And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD. 4 Your clothing did not wear out on you and your foot did not swell these forty years. 5 Know then in your heart that, as a man disciplines his son, the LORD your God disciplines you. 6 So you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God by walking in his ways and by fearing him. - **Deuteronomy 8:2-6 ESV**

### **I. God uses difficult situations to teach us to depend on Him.**

### **II. We need to learn to wait on God.**

1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. 2 And after fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. 3 And the tempter came and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command these stones to become loaves of bread." 4 But he answered, "It

is written, "'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" ... 11 Then the devil left him, and behold, angels came and were ministering to him. - **Matthew 4:1-4, 11 ESV**

**Where are you tempted to take matters into your own hands?  
Wait on God.**

### **III. The only way that we can be spiritually nourished is by feeding on God's word.**

3 And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD. - **Deuteronomy 8:3 ESV**

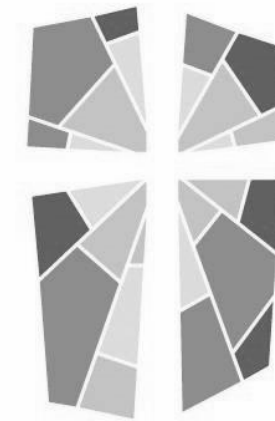

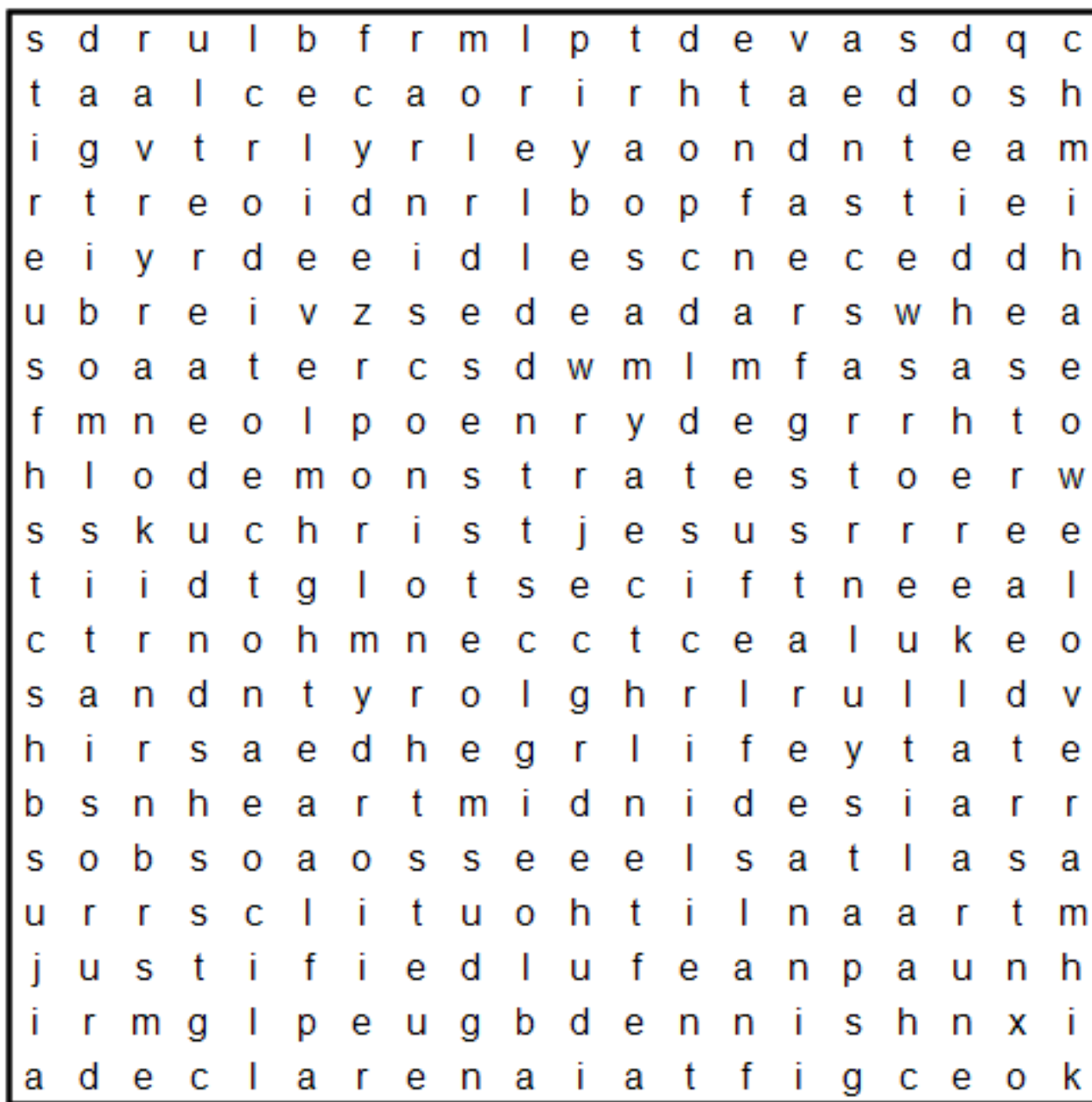
Prayer Requests from our neighbors:
