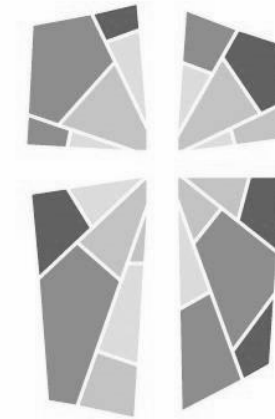

Luke 19:12-27

“We Each Will Give an Account”

I. Believers will each give an account for what they have done.

10 Why do you pass judgment on your brother? Or you, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God; - **Romans 14:10 ESV**

7 for we walk by faith, not by sight. 8 Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. 9 So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil. - **2 Corinthians 5:7-10 ESV**

22 For the Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son, - **John 5:22 ESV**

II. Salvation is not at stake

1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. - **Romans 8:1 ESV**

10 According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it. 11 For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw-- 13 each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. 14 If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. 15 If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire. - **1 Corinthians 3:10-15 ESV**

III. What will we have to account for?

1 This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. 2 Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful. 3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by any human court. In fact, I do not even

judge myself. 4 For I am not aware of anything against myself, but I am not thereby acquitted. It is the Lord who judges me. 5 Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God. - **1 Corinthians 4:1-5 ESV**

35 The good person out of his good treasure brings forth good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure brings forth evil. 36 I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, - **Matthew 12:35-36 ESV**

27 For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done. - **Matthew 16:27 ESV**

IV. Run to obtain the prize.

28 And now, little children, abide in him, so that when he appears we may have confidence and not shrink from him in shame at his coming. - **1 John 2:28 ESV**

24 Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it. 25 Every athlete exercises self-control in all things. They do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. 26 So I do not run aimlessly; I do not box as one beating the air. 27 But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified. - **1 Corinthians 9:24-27 ESV**

16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. - **Galatians 5:16 ESV**

What Action Can You Take?

I. Admit where you fall short.

II. Thank God for His grace and mercy.

III. Don't be anxious about the past, but run to win the race.
