

#### Matthew 27:33-44

### "Where Is the King?"

#### I. The King is not in a palace.

1 Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, 2 [continually] saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him." - Matthew 2:1-2 ESV

#### II. The King is riding on a donkey.

1 Now when they drew near to Jerusalem and came to Bethphage, to the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, 2 saying to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them to me. 3 If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will send them at once." 4 This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying, 5 "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your king is coming to you, humble, and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.'" 6 The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them. 7 They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them. 8 Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. 9 And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!" - Matthew 21:1-9 ESV

#### III. The King is nailed to a cross.

33 And when they came to a place called Golgotha (which means Place of a Skull), 34 they offered him wine to drink, mixed with gall, but when he tasted it, he would not drink it. 35 And when they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots. 36 Then they sat down and kept watch over him there. 37 And over his head they put the charge against him, which read, "This is Jesus, the King of the Jews." 38 Then two robbers were crucified with him, one on the right and one on the left. 39 And those who passed by derided him, wagging their heads 40 and saying, "You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself! If you are the Son of God, come down from the cross." 41 So also the chief priests, with the scribes and elders, mocked him, saying, 42 "He saved others; he cannot save himself. He is the King of Israel; let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. 43 He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, 'I am the Son of God.'" 44 And the robbers who were crucified with him also reviled him in the same way. - Matthew 27:33-44 ESV

6 For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For one will scarcely die for a righteous person--though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die-- 8 but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. - Romans 5:6-8 ESV

#### IV. Your King is at the right hand of the Father.

34 ... Christ Jesus is the one who died--more than that, who was raised--who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. - **Romans 8:34 ESV** 

15 ... [Jesus Christ] who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, 16 who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light ... - 1 Timothy 6:15-16 ESV

8 And being found in human form, [Christ] humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. - **Philippians 2:8-11 ESV**  "Where is the King" April 10,2022

If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross." <sup>41</sup> Likewise the chief priests also, mocking with the <u>scribes</u> and <u>elders</u>, said, <sup>42</sup>"He saved others; <u>Himself</u> He cannot save. If He is the King of <u>Israel</u>, let Him now come down from the <u>cross</u>, and we will believe Him. <sup>43</sup>He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.'" <sup>44</sup>Even the robbers who were crucified with Him reviled Him with the same thing.
