

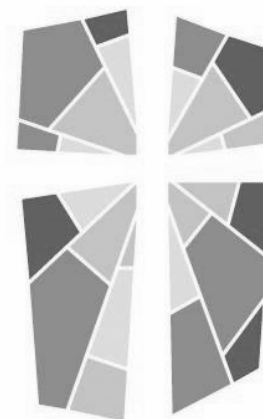

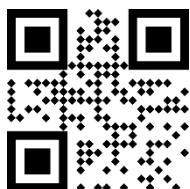

I. What does it mean to be self-sufficient?

**“able to take care of oneself or itself without outside help.” –
*Merriam-Webster dictionary***

If something is not self-sufficient, then it is dependent.

II. The Bible teaches us that God is self-sufficient.

7 "Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I [am] God, your God! 8 I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices Or your burnt offerings, [Which are] continually before Me. 9 I will not take a bull from your house, [Nor] goats out of your folds. 10 For every beast of the forest [is] Mine, [And] the cattle on a thousand hills. 11 I know all the birds of the mountains, And the wild beasts of the field [are] Mine. 12 "If I were hungry, I would not tell you; For the world [is] Mine, and all its fullness.

IV. Does it matter that God is self-sufficient?

- 1. If God is not self-sufficient, then He would depend on someone else. They would then have power over God.**
- 2. We need to repent of our belief that God needs us or anyone else.**
- 3. Since God is self-sufficient, then your salvation depends on Him.**
- 4. God's self-sufficiency should lead us to worship Him**
