^{Luke 23:32-43} Two others, who were <u>criminals</u>, were led away to be put to <u>death</u> with him. ³³ And when they came to the place that is called The <u>Skull</u>, there they <u>crucified</u> him, and the criminals, one on his <u>right</u> and one on his <u>left</u>. ³⁴ And <u>Jesus</u> said, "<u>Father</u>, forgive them, for they know not what they do." Save yourself and us!" ⁴⁰ But the other <u>rebuked</u> him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of <u>condemnation</u>? ⁴¹ And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due <u>reward</u> of our <u>deeds</u>; but this man has done nothing wrong." ⁴² And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your <u>kingdom</u>." ⁴³ And he said to him, "<u>Truly</u>, I say to you, today you will be with me in <u>paradise</u>."
