Isaiah 6:1-5

"Knowing Your Father - God is Holy"

I. What does "holy" mean?

Both the Hebrew and Greek words translated "holy" mean "separate, different, or set apart."

Often it refers to moral purity.

It can also refer to people or things that are set apart.

II. What does Scripture teach us about God's holiness?

God is holy.

1 In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of his robe filled the temple. 2 Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" 4 And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke. 5 And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!" - Isaiah 6:1-5 ESV

God is separate and different than everything else

5 I am the LORD, and there is no other, besides me there is no God; I equip you, though you do not know me, - Isaiah 45:5 ESV

God is morally perfect

4 For you are not a God who delights in wickedness; evil may not dwell with you. - Psalm 5:4 ESV

5 This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. - 1 John 1:5 ESV

God's holiness exposes our sinfulness

7 And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."

- Isaiah 6:7 ESV

 $4 \dots$ [God] chose us in [Christ] before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love

- Ephesians 1:4 ESV [How? Blood of Jesus]

9 You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. 10 But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. 11 If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

- Romans 8:9-11 ESV

III. How can we apply the truth that God is holy?

God's holiness should lead us to worship Him.

We should be cleansed by God.

We should pursue holiness in or lives.

1 Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God. - 2 Corinthians 7:1 ESV

13 Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 14 As obedient children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, 15 but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, 16 since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy." - 1 Peter 1:13-16 ESV
