### I. **We were dead, separated from God (vv. 1-3)**

1 And you were dead ...

... in the trespasses and sins ...

2 in which you once walked, following the course of this world, ...

13 "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. 14 For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few. - **Matthew 7:13-14 ESV**

... following the prince of the power of the air ...

... the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience ...

3 among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind ...

### II. **But God ... made us alive. (vv. 4-5)**

4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ--by grace you have been saved






