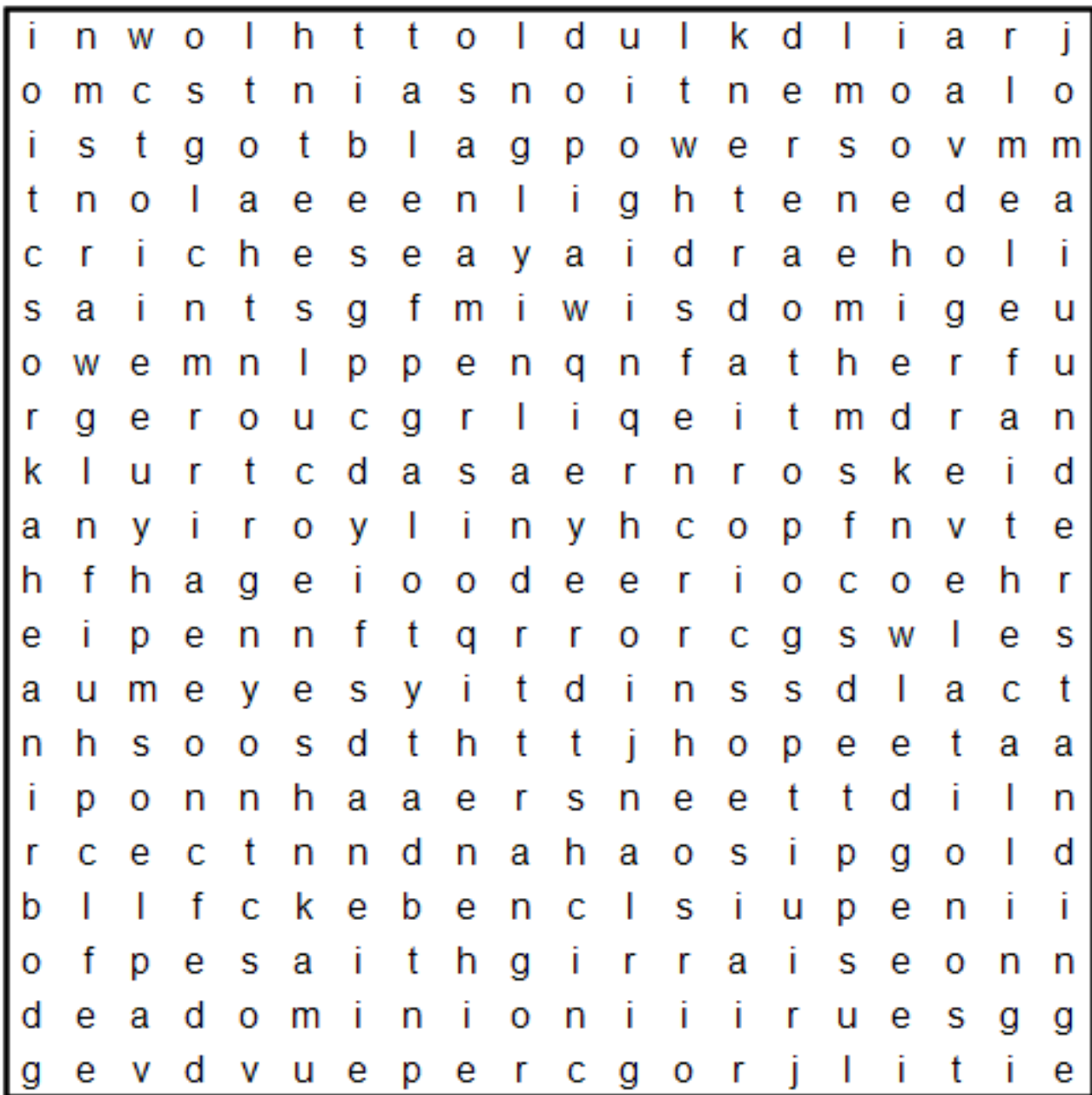


"A Prayer for One Another"

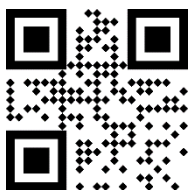

I. Pray that we each would have deeper knowledge of our Father. (vv. 15-18a)

15 Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, 16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of your understanding [heart] being enlightened; - **Ephesians 1:15-18a NKJV**

3 "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. - **John 17:3 NKJV**

II. Pray that we each would know the hope of our Father's calling. (v. 18b)

that you may know what is the hope [certainty] of His calling,

- **Ephesians 1:18b NKJV**

III. Pray that we each would know the riches of our inheritance. (v. 18c)
