


# “Having Nothing but Giving Everything”

Acts 3: 1-10 <sup>1</sup> Now **Peter** and **John** went up together to the **temple** at the **hour** of **prayer**, the **ninth** hour. <sup>2</sup> And a certain **man lame** from his mother's **womb** was carried, whom they **laid** daily at the **gate** of the temple which is called **Beautiful**, to ask **alms** from those who entered the temple; <sup>3</sup> who, seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple, asked for alms. <sup>4</sup> And fixing his **eyes** on him, with John, Peter said, "Look at us." <sup>5</sup> So he gave them his **attention**, expecting to **receive** something from them. <sup>6</sup> Then Peter said, "**Silver** and **gold** I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth, rise up and **walk**." <sup>7</sup> And he took him by the right **hand** and lifted him up, and immediately his **feet** and **ankle** bones received strength. <sup>8</sup> So he, leaping up, **stood** and walked and entered the temple with them—walking, **leaping**, and **praising** God. <sup>9</sup> And all the people saw him walking and praising God. <sup>10</sup> Then they knew that it was he who **sat** begging alms at the Beautiful Gate of the temple; and they were **filled** with **wonder** and **amazement** at what had happened to him. 
