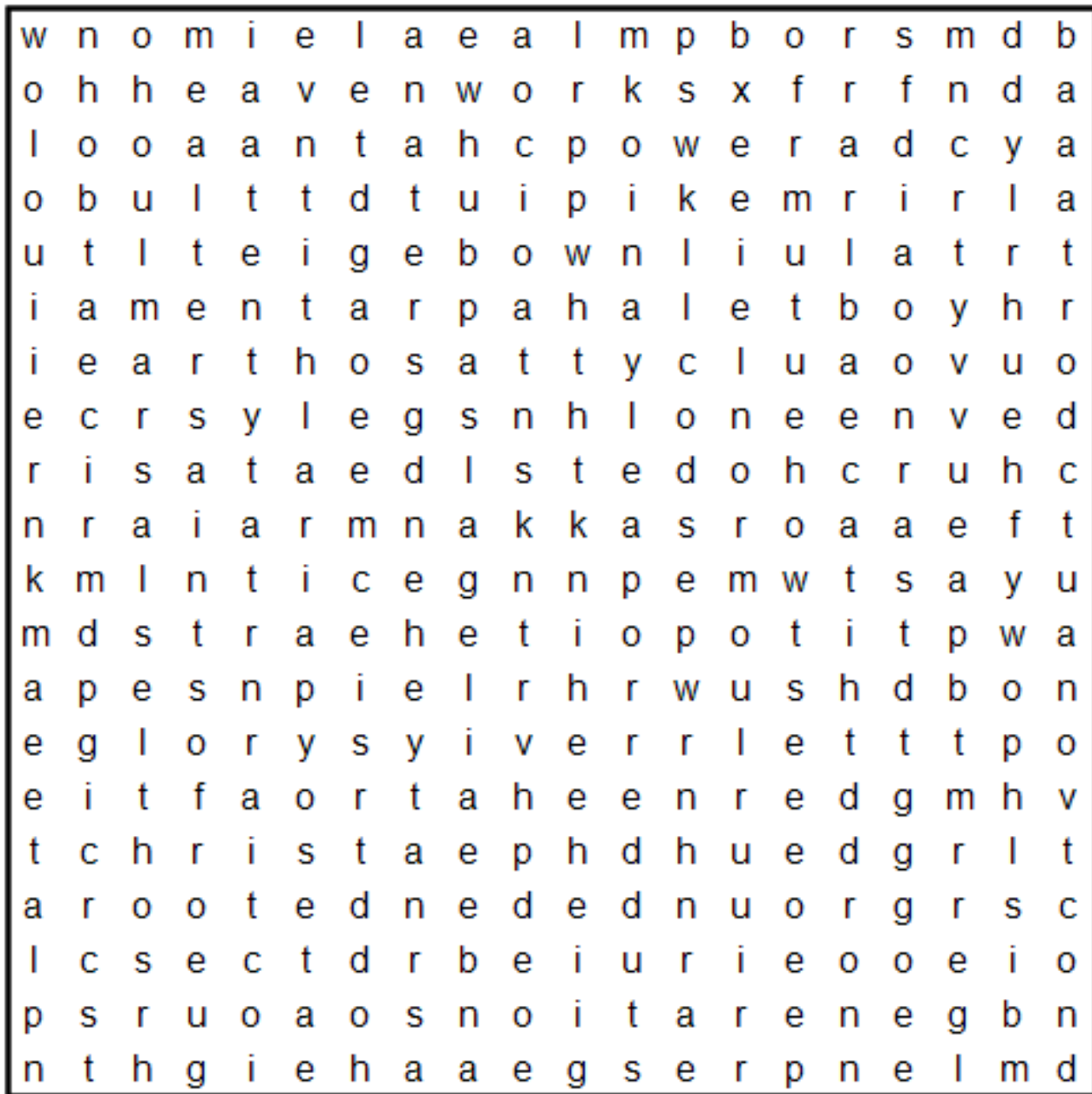
III. We can know that God is able to do more than we imagine
