**Ephesians 4:1-6**

**“We Are Family”**

**I. We have been invited into a relationship. (v. 1)**

1 I therefore, ... - **Ephesians 4:1a ESV**

**Have you accepted God’s invitation?**

**Do you believe the blessings of God are yours?**

1 ... a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, - **Ephesians 4:1b ESV**

**Has your relationship with God made a difference in your life?**

5 Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?-- unless indeed you fail to meet the test! - **2 Corinthians 13:5 ESV**

**II. We have to fight for unity. (vv. 2-3)**

**Who do we have to fight?**

2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. - **Ephesians 4:2-3 ESV**

28 Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.  
29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.  
- **Matthew 11:28-29 ESV**

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.  
- **Galatians 5:22-23 ESV**

4 Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant 5 or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; 6 it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. 7 Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.  
- **1 Corinthians 13:4-7 ESV**


**III. We are united by and in God. (vv. 4-6)**
