

1 For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles ... 13 So I ask you not to lose heart over what I am suffering for you, which is your glory. - **Ephesians 3:1-13 ESV**

1 Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, ...

21 For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. 22 If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell. 23 I am hard pressed between the two. 
