I. The Holy Spirit intercedes for us. (v. 18a)

18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. **-Ephesians 6:18a**

26 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. 27 And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God. - **Romans 8:26-27 ESV**

II. We should intercede for other believers. (v. 18b)

To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints **-Ephesians 6:18b**

30 I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf, **- Romans 15:30 ESV**
